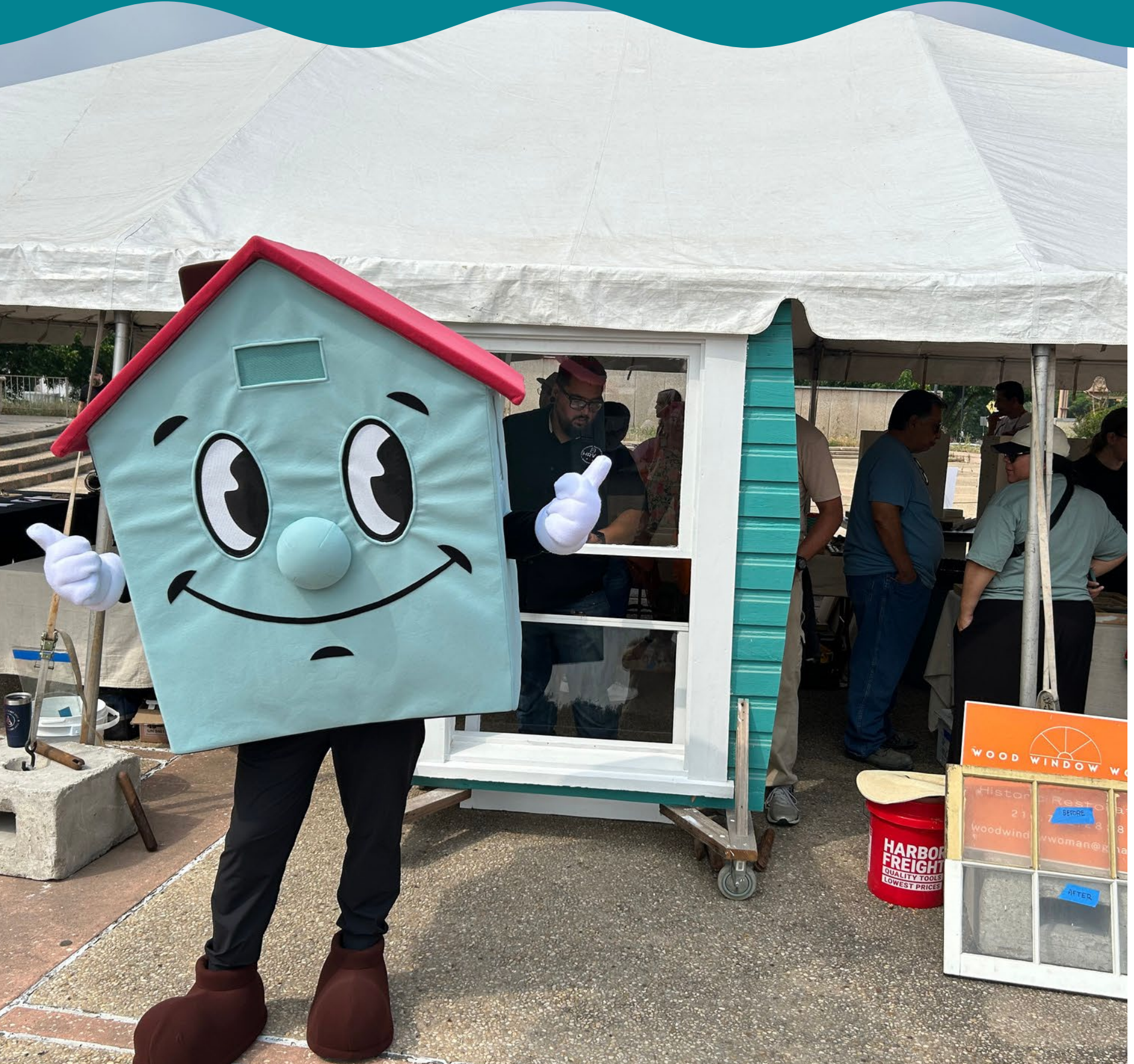

- The mission is to capture San Antonio's previously untold, underrepresented, or erased history (lower-case "h" histories).



# Local Markers Program

## HISTORY HERE

- History Here is a low-cost, community-reviewed markers program.
- The intention of the program is to reduce the barriers to entry for applicants that may be interested in a more formal marker.



# Legacy Businesses

The Legacy Business Program acknowledges the contributions of local businesses that have been in operation for around 20+ years and contribute to the history, culture, and authentic identity of San Antonio.



# Cultural Heritage Districts

Cultural Heritage District recognition is a community driven, place-based recognition of intangible heritage (traditions, food, music, arts). The program complements existing programs, local markers, legacy business, etc.

Office of Historic Preservation (OHP) reviews exterior modifications and repairs for the following type of properties and requests per the City's Unified Development Code (UDC):

- Historic Districts
- Individual Landmarks
- Public Facilities/Right-of-Way
- Properties determined eligible for historic designation
- Demolitions
- Downtown zoning
- River Improvement Overlay districts
- Viewsheds/Mission Protection Overlay District

# Deconstruction Ordinance

- Adopted September 2022
- San Antonio's oldest small-scale housing stock is required to be deconstructed and salvaged.
- Year date thresholds: 1945, 1960
